PSA

"Expensive Night"

There was a lot of thought that went into choosing the right public service announcement to record. I wanted to pick something that is relatable to people inside my age group. I had to consider a PSA that will intrigue the listener within the first few seconds. I went through a lot of them on a website, www.psacentral.org. This was a great site with a lot of different kinds of approaches promoting all sorts of really great causes. I really enjoyed listening to them because they influenced my decision of the approach I wanted to use.

I ultimately chose to use the PSA entitled "Expensive Night". This is campaign against buzzed driving. It has a humorous tone and real world situations that the listener can relate to. It tells a very vivid story about a guy who gets pulled over for drunk driving, even though he's only buzzed. It starts off with a male going on a "guys night out" with his friends. The male is having a great time with his friends buying pitchers of beer, playing pool, taking photos and having dinner. All the while, he's spending more and more money to do so. By the end of the night, he makes his way back to his car and he is ultimately pulled over and arrested for driving while intoxicated. The end result being that he is now faced with all kinds of fines, legal fees, court costs, warrants, as well as other unnecessary payments. His night of fun has become the most "expensive night" of his life.

The main attraction will be in the design of the sound effects. I want to create the same atmosphere in order to better engage the listener. It has a lighthearted, fun tone with a very serious message. The PSA, which is directed towards men between the ages of 21 and 35, inspire young men to examine their behavior and take responsibility for their own decision to get behind the wheel after having a few drinks.

My plan is to have an adult male, preferably within the target audience (21-35) to deliver the voiceover throughout. I have to find someone with a believable, but informative tone to narrate the story. I would need someone who is mature with a professional voice to give the overall message. I could also use an additional voice to do background vocals to actually act as the male lead. After I have selected my voiceover artist, I will need to use the main studio to record them reading the script I will have already prepared, plus all the normal studio documentation. (i.e., studio setup, production notes, patch bay, etc.) When all is said & done, I plan to use this piece on my professional website.


